



Steps for Church Participation

1. Sermon Series

- During the month of April, church leadership activates a neighbouring campaign.
- Deliver original sermon series or supplemental second sermon series.
- Use of other available resources (i.e. power point, videos, etc)

2. Set A Goal

- Work with your congregation to set achievable goals. For example, how many block parties can your members lead?
- Challenge members to register on the St. Albert Good Neighbours matching web site as someone who will attend, help or lead a block party on their street.

3. Keep the Momentum Going

- Appoint a member(s) of your church to promote this initiative and mentor others.
- Encourage members to attend a Block Party Boot Camp
- Track your progress and invite members to share their experiences all summer
- Celebrate successes, small and large
